Early arrivals or late departures: please make advanced arrangements.

- Sleeping bag or sheets and pillowcase (\$5.00 fee for the use of linens provided by the Retreat Center)
- Towels and personal hygiene items.
- Clothing appropriate to wear at a pilgrimage place dedicated to Mary. Key word: WWMW (What Would Mary Wear!)
- Blouses should not be too short or revealing.
- Shorts should be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
- A modest dress with sleeves or skirt (not mini skirts) and blouse for Holy Mass.
- One piece swimming suit.
- Appropriate clothing for outdoor activities.

Follow Highway 14 to the west end of Sleepy Eye. Turn North as indicated by the road marker (just before the Del Monte Plant). Drive under the Hillesheim Memorial Arch down the driveway to the Retreat Center. (**For GPS or Mapquest use 840 Prescott Ave NW—go on road under archway to Retreat Center.**)

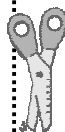
